Use of the Test Federation is available to organisations and institutions which undertake or support education, research or research and development, including:

- Tertiary Education Institutions, such as universities or vocational education institutions;
- Government, Commercial Research Institutions and not-for-profit entities; and
- Government or Commercial Product and Service Organisations delivering products or services to the education and research sector.
